Objectives of NSS Cell, NCMS

Objectives of NSS Cell-NCMS are framed in line with the NSS objectives at National level.

- 1. To identify the needs and problems of the community and society and involve in resolving process.
 - 2. To develop social and civic responsibility among the NSS volunteers
 - 3. To utilize volunteers' expertise and knowledge in finding solution to individual &community issues surrounding us.
 - 4. To develop competence required for group living and sharing of responsibilities.

- 5. To gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- 6. To acquire leadership abilities and self-governing attitude.
- 7. To develop ability to overcome and help in crises and natural disasters.
- 8. To practice national integration and social harmony.

NSS Units

- 1. The number of units to the college will be allotted by the Programme Coordinator in consultation with NSS Regional Centre and State Liaison Officer considering the demands of the institution.
- 2. The strength of a unit will be 100 NSS volunteers and will be extended up to 120 volunteers in exceptional cases where second unit cannot be raised due to constraints.
- 3. In exceptional cases, when the total strength of students enrolled is very small, a smaller NSS unit will be started with the strength of 75 NSS volunteers.

Enrollment of NSS Volunteers

- 1. At college level the NSS volunteers will be enrolled from the first- and second-year degree-class students. Preference will be given to the students who have worked as NSS volunteers at +2 levels also.
- 2. The students from foreign countries studying in NCMS will also be encouraged to join NSS, so that they may share the experiences of national reconstruction and community work.

Regulations to be a Programme Officer

- 1. One Programme Officer will be in charge of one unit only.
- 2. Only those belonging to the teaching faculty will be considered for appointment as Programme Officer.
- Programme Officer will be responsible for the organization of NSS unit, implementation
 of NSS Programme under the supervision and direction of Principal of the college or
 Head of the institution.
- 4. The Programme Officer will be taking the responsibility to carry out the instructions issued by the Programme Coordinator of the University, NSS Regional Centre and State Liaison Officer for the implementation of NSS activities as per the NSS Manual, Programme guidelines and administrative and policy directives.

Schedule of a meeting

- 1. The committee would be meeting formally at the beginning of the academic year to plan activities for the entire year and submit a strategic perspective plan.
- 2. There would be a meeting at the end of the academic year to review the activities.
- 3. The committee formally and informally meets as many times as required depending on the need.

Roles of Volunteer

- 1. All volunteers shall work under the guidance of the group leader nominated by the Programme officer.
- 2. They shall make themselves worthy of the confidence and cooperation of the group /community leadership.
- 3. They shall scrupulously avoid entering any controversial issues.
- 4. They shall keep day-to-day records of their activities / experience in the enclosing pages of the diary and submit to the Group Leader/ Program Officer for periodic guidance.
- 5. It is obligatory on the part of every volunteer to wear the NSS Badge while on work.

Responsibilities of Volunteer

- 1. To establish support with the people in the project area.
- 2. Identify needs, problems, and resources of the community.
- 3. Plan programmes and carry out the plans.
- Relate his/her learning and experience towards finding solutions to the problems identified.
- 5. Record the activities in his/her work diary symmetrically and assess the progress periodically and effect changes as and when needed.
