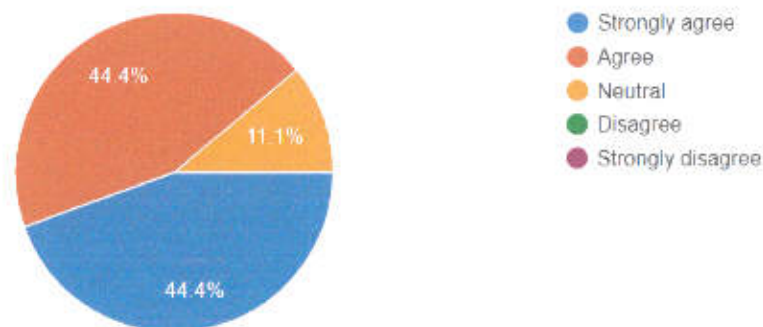


Faculty Feedback Report-2021-22

Analysis of Feedback from Faculty (2021-22)

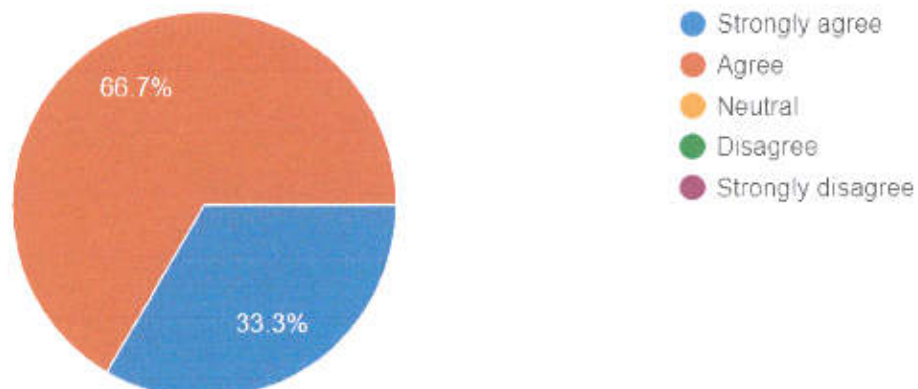
As a regular practice, IQAC collects the feedback from the Faculty to ensure the quality education in the college every academic year.

2. The emphasis of the curriculum has been on refining and enhancing skills.

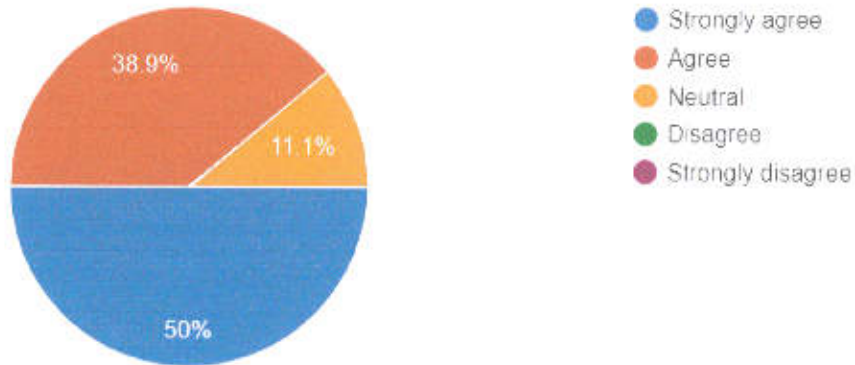


Analysis: Out of all respondents, majority said that curriculum focuses on refining and enhancing skills.



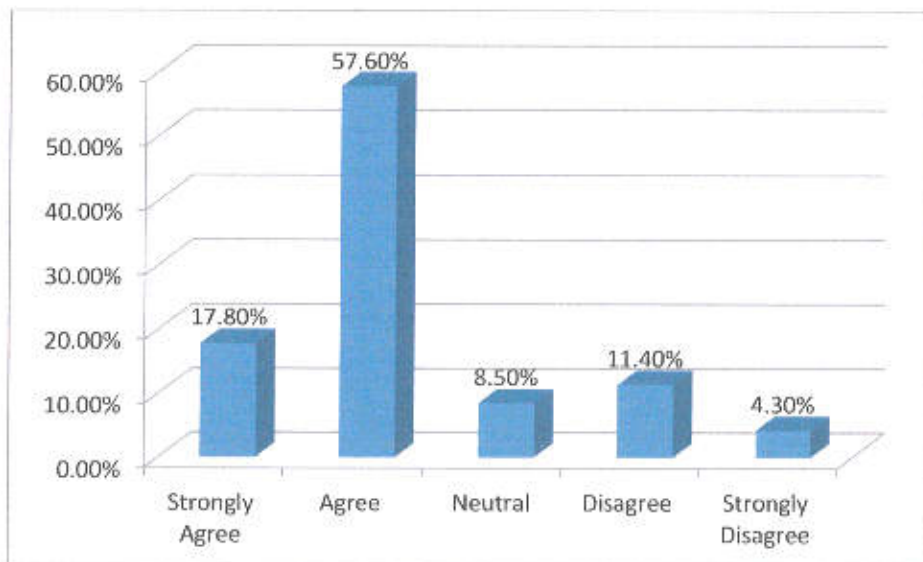

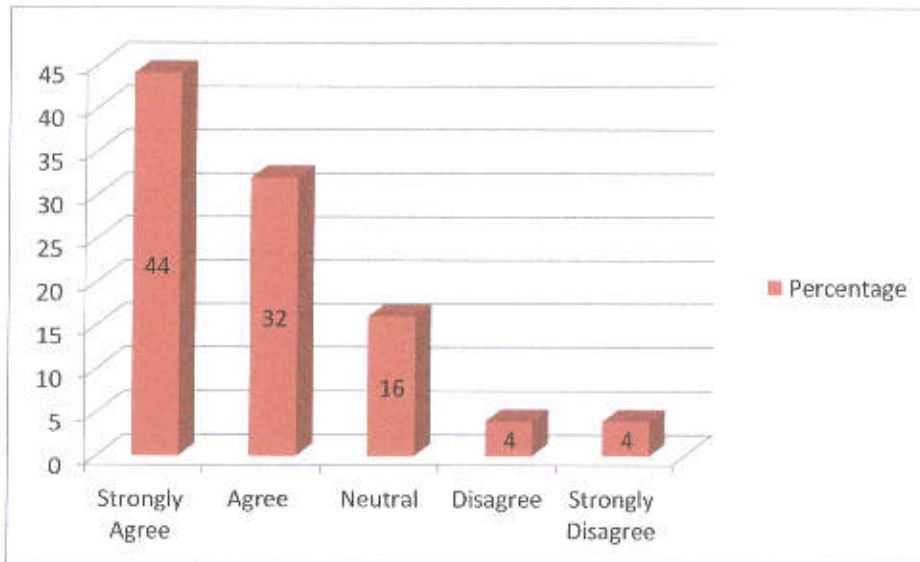
4. Institution is provided with good infrastructure, ICT enabled classroom and office.

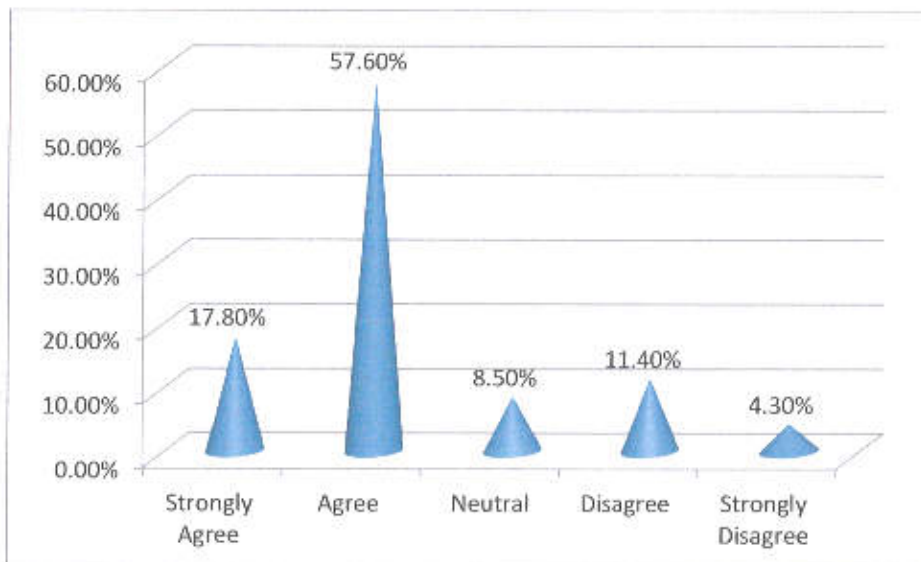

5. **Financial Assistance is given by Institution to facilitate research enthusiasm of faculties.**



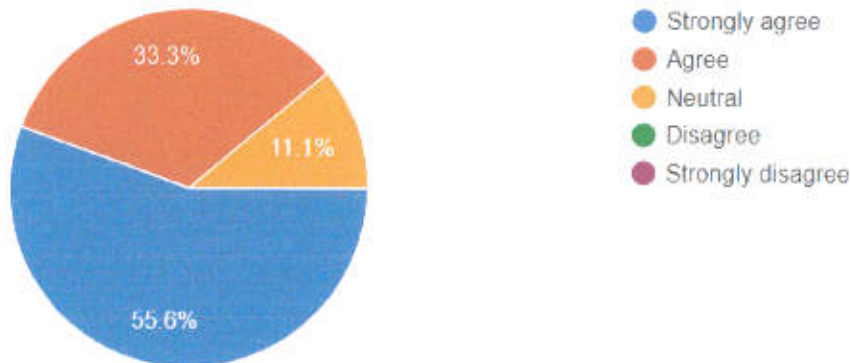
Analysis: Out of all respondents, majority (76%) gave positive response and others gave mixed opinions on this statement.

6. **Professional development training (within the college) is provided by the Institution.**



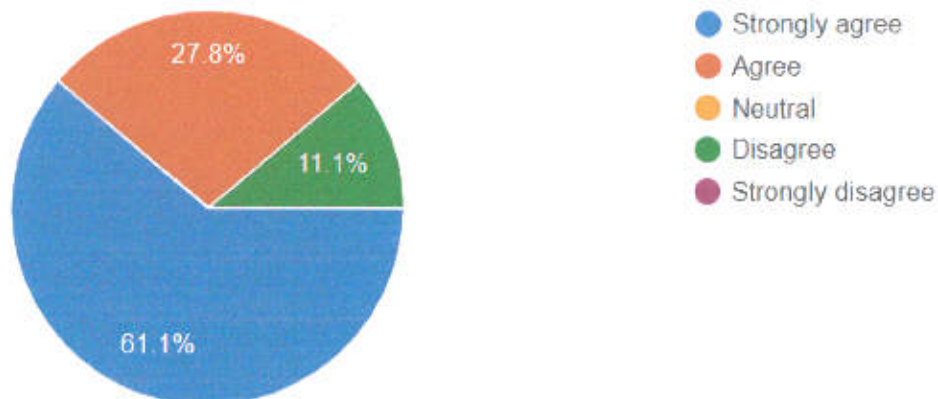
Analysis: Out of all respondents, majority (75.4%) said that they have attended FDP organized in the college.

Analysis: Out of all respondents, majority (88.9%) either agreed or strongly agreed with the statement.

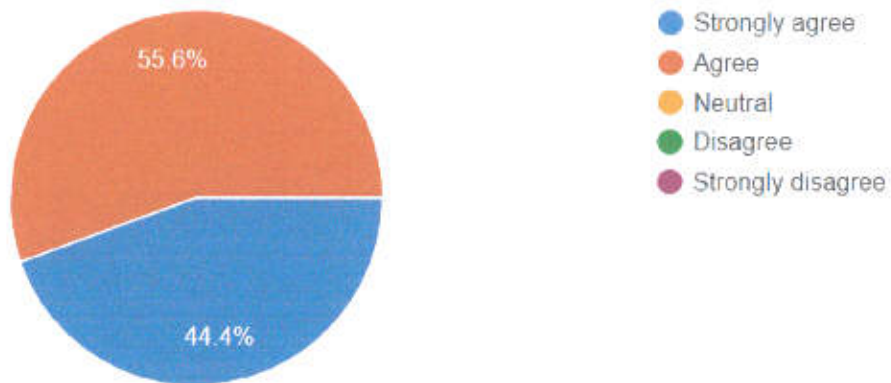
8. Equal Opportunities for Staff



Analysis: Out of all respondents, majority (88.9%) is satisfied with the opportunities and only few were not happy with the opportunities available.

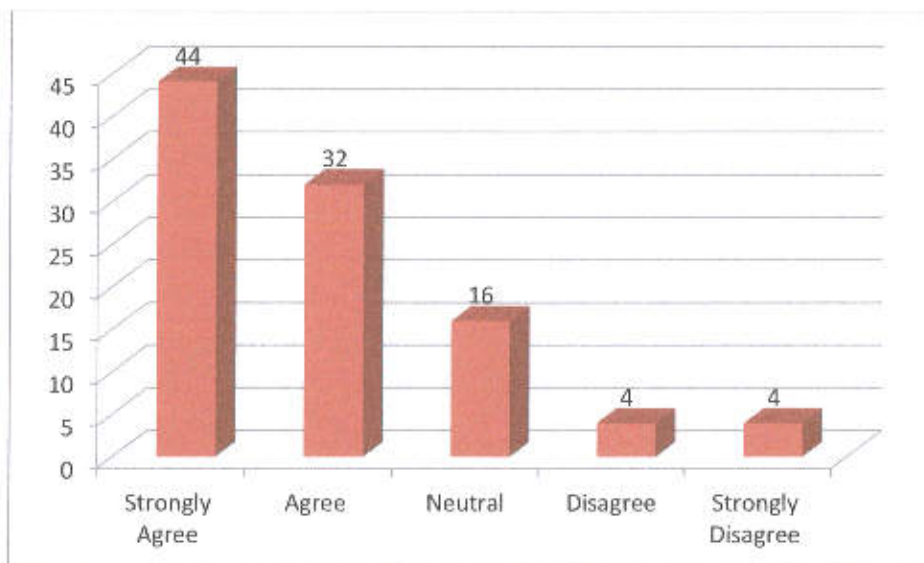

Analysis: All the respondents were either agreed or strongly agreed that they are satisfied with the medical facilities at the college.

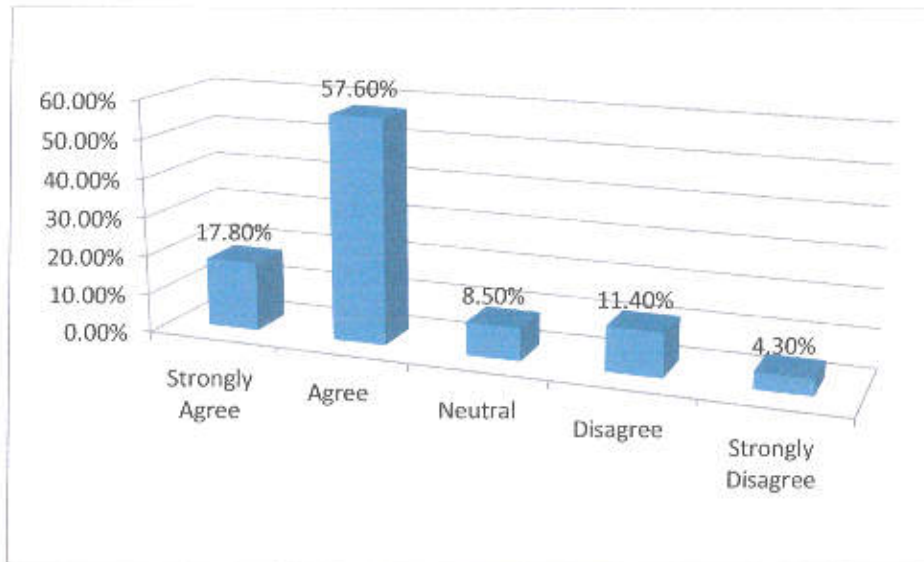
10. Feedback Mechanism and its effectiveness
