04 September 2019

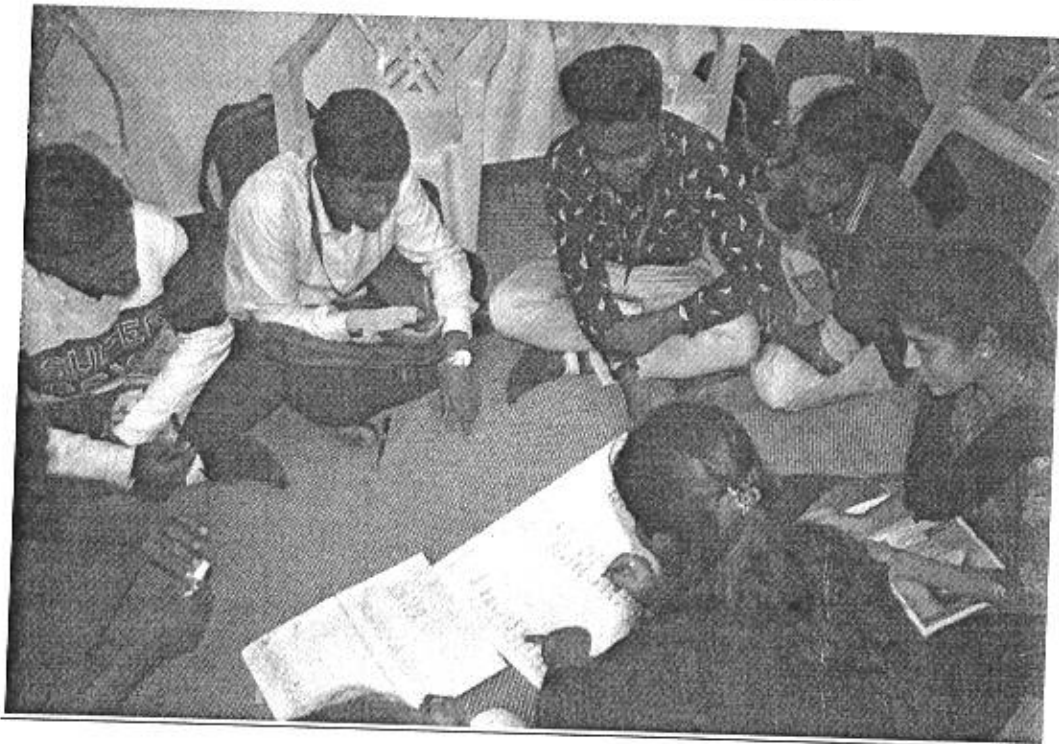

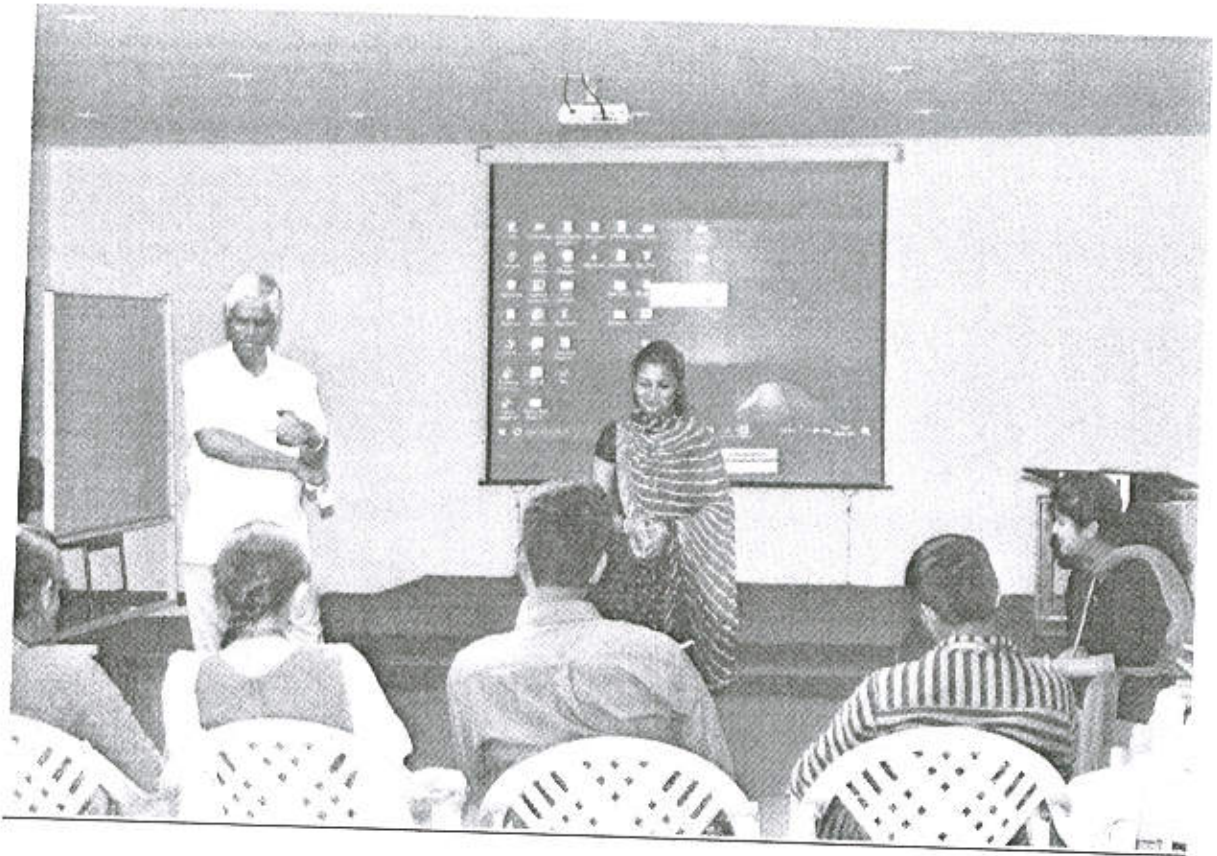




## DAY 4

Having intensively trained in Tavi model of behavioural science applications I am continuing to translate the skill and technology to suit the grass root development work needs and in a local language (Kannada) integrating it with other development specialized skills and technologies.

I keep on innovating and exploring concepts and strategies to address socio-economic issues, set up systems, prepare team and provide hand-holding support till they are able to sustain on their own. A session was held by Mr. Sudhindra D S, a practicing chartered account on 13 September 2019 regarding GST. Mr. Sudhindra D S explained about the meaning of GST ,it's history and launch in India. 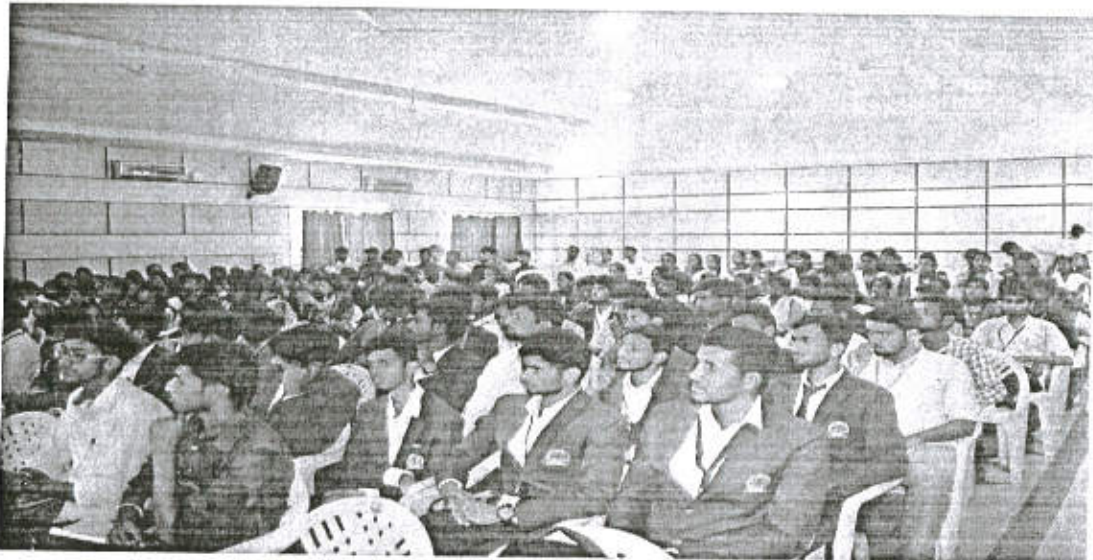
