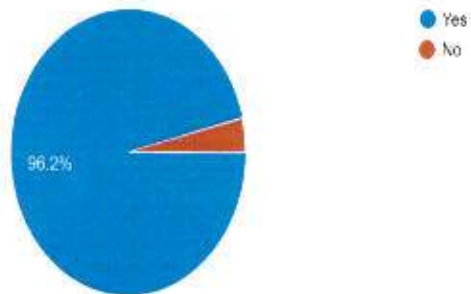

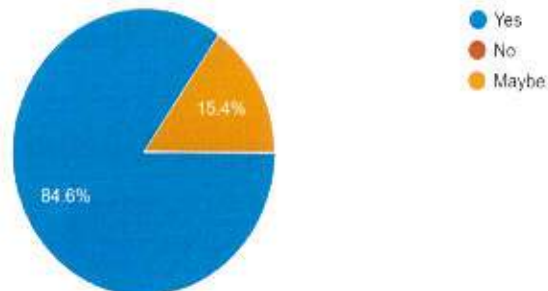

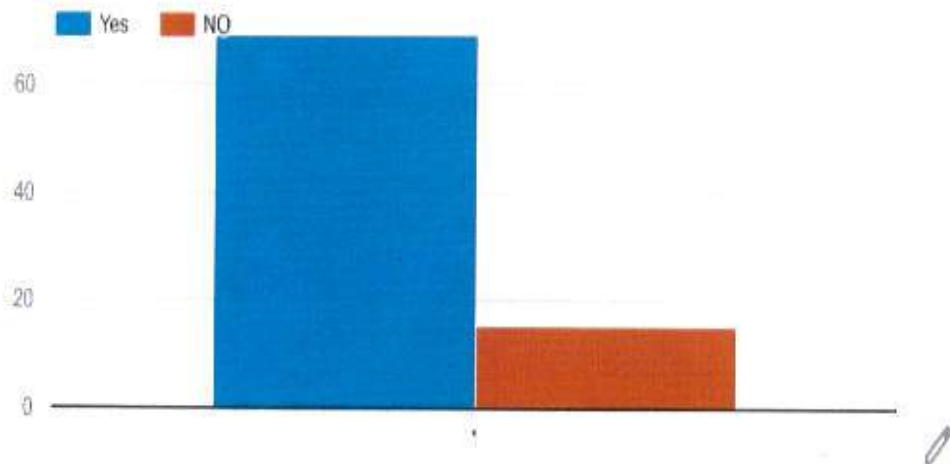

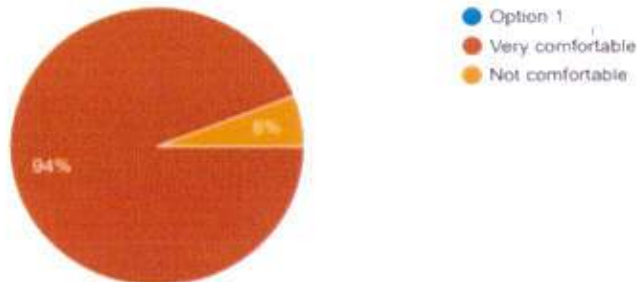

- Both criminalizing ragging and addressing psychological stress due to sexual harassment are steps towards creating safer, more respectful, and empathetic educational environments and societies in general.

Brief write-up about the Programme:

Anti-sexual Harassment Committee of Nagarjuna College of Management Studies organized a guest talk on “Ragging is a Criminal Offence & Psychological Stress due to Sexual Harassment” to aware the students about this program on 20/07/2023 in the college Auditorium. The program was organized jointly by Anti-Ragging committee and Anti-sexual Harassment committee, to raise awareness and to promote a secured and respectful environment for all the students and staff. The esteemed guest speaker for the talk was Mr. K.M. MuneGowda Advocate; a renowned legal expert with more than 20 Junior Advocates who specializes in gender rights and sexual harassment cases.

Learning outcome:

- MrMuncGowda began the talk by emphasizing the significance of committees in the institutions and public spaces in ensuring a safe environment especially for students.
- He also stressed on various societal problems like ragging in educational institutions, which also might take the form of Sexual harassment and the various ways of preventing these problems in initial stage of inception.
- Sir also emphasized on various issues that hampers the growth of today's youth particularly students in their teenage like social media, mobile addiction, addiction to drugs and other negative things, intentional or unintentional forwarding of sexual content through mobile phones, kinesics, haptic, and proxemics and its effect on the opposite person.
- He concludes by specifying certain rights and laws which could be handled carefully. At the end of the schedule, the students were impressed with the information and cautions.

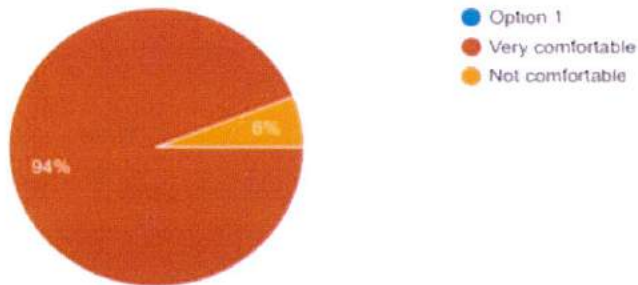

Brief write-up about the Programme:

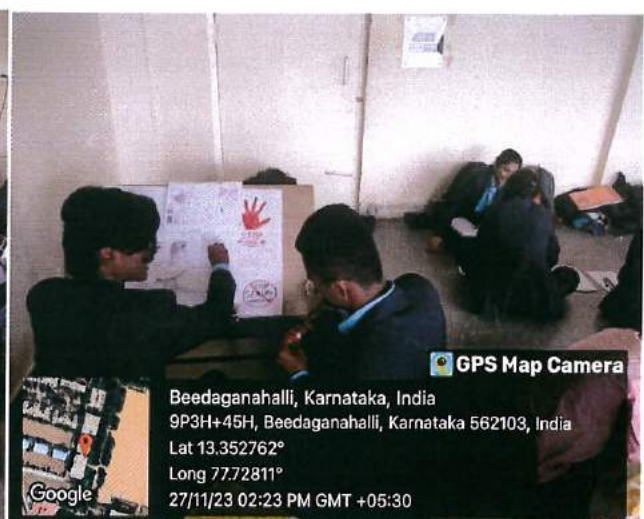

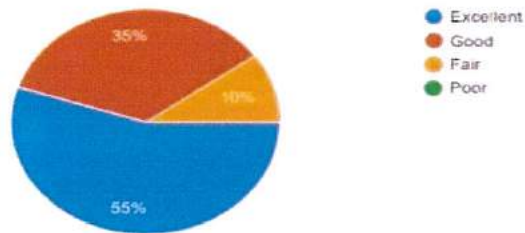

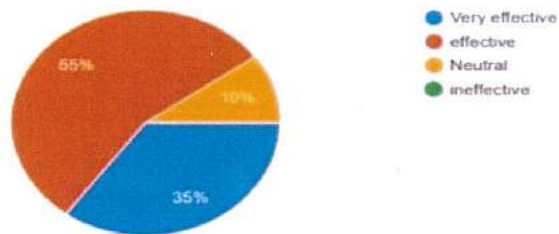

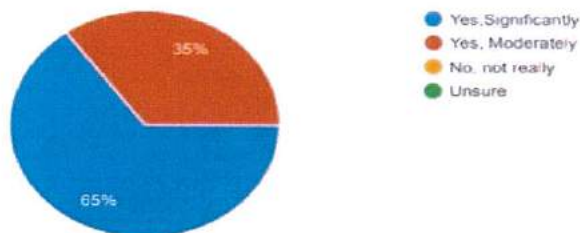

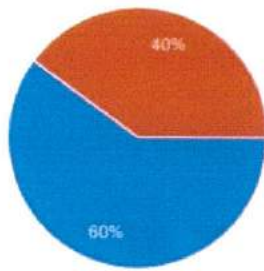

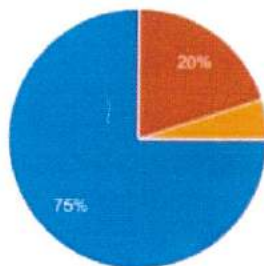

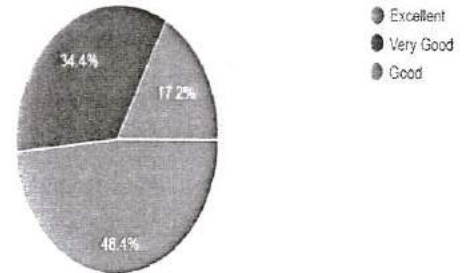

Objectives:

- It helps students understand the stigma attached and challenges faced by trans people in the society.
- It aids students to realize the ways in which marginalization impacts a trans persons' life.
- To accept trans people as much as other human beings.

Brief write-up about the Programme:

Dr. Akkai Padmashali, the well-known transgender activist was the guest speaker of the day. Padmashali narrated her story as a transgender woman, she was assigned male at birth, but realized at a young age that her gender identity was female. In the talk, Padmashali explained that the sociological context in which she was born was not conducive to free expression of her gender identity. Padmashali spoke of leaving home when she was only a teenager and experiencing several turbulent years full of hardship and depression.

Later in the talk she said, how as a trans woman she willingly raises her voice for the transgender community to spread awareness. She agrees with the point made that the struggle of the trans community is never-ending. She added that social discrimination against the trans community exists, but we need to combat against it. Emphasizing the constitutional values, Padmashali says that "No one has the right to decide my identity... It's the constitutional right of every Indian. We need to promote inclusivity". The activist wrapped up her talk on an optimistic note, "It is high

time in the 21st century to fight against all forms of phobias, to speak for social justice and social acceptance,” Padmashali said.
