Journey of Education in India - Part 3

After exploring the Gurukuls and British-era classrooms, the next destination is the National Education Policy (NEP 2020).

In today's era of digitalisation, this shift in education bestows one with the autonomy of choice in choosing one's path. It aims to bring experiential learning into the picture by focusing on improving cognitive, analytical, creative, and interpersonal skills.

NEP introduced a new structure for providing education known as the 5+3+3+4 structure. The first five years are the foundation, which focuses play-based learning methods and the development of language skills. The next three years are considered to be the preparatory stage where the focus lies on the development of numeracy, language, and cognitive skills. Then, the succeeding three years, known as the middle stage, are dedicated to the experiential learning of various subjects. Whereas the last four years, called as the secondary stage, will provide a choice in the subjects of specialisations and promote flexibility and multi-disciplinary education.

This structure focuses on optimising education for learners based on their cognitive development. With this systematic yet unique approach, education showcases the spirit of inclusiveness and equity that encourages and builds a nation of excellence.






National Entrepreneurship Day 2023







